Our Shape, Space and Measure work will involve learning about area and perimeter.

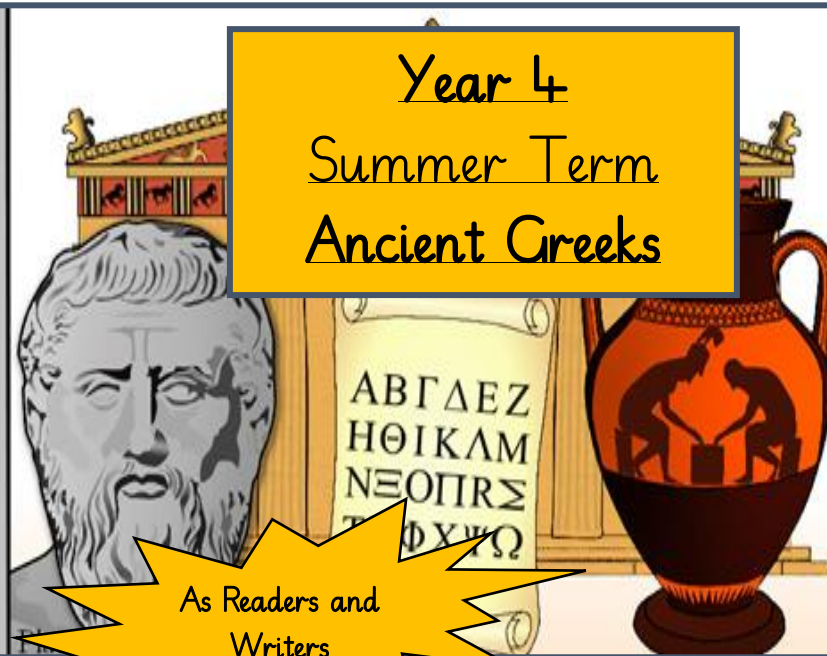
As Designers and Artists

As Scientists

As Readers and Writers

We will be reading Greek myths and exploring how these types of stories are constructed. We will then be innovating and retelling a known myth. We will also be writing magazine articles, letters, newspaper articles and much more!

During our English lessons we will continue to refine our grammar skills with a focus on using different sentence types, speech punctuation, tenses and using fronted adverbials in our writing.

Our Reading lessons will link to our writing outcomes, providing a range of fiction and non-fiction texts to challenge and inspire.

We will continue to work on Y3/4 spelling patterns and statutory spellings.

As Geographers and Historians

We will be locating the UK and Greece on a map and comparing modern day Greece to the Greek Empire built by Alexander the Great.

We will investigate the historical events that have taken place in Ancient Greece and look at the Ancient Greek democracy and compare it with the current UK democratic system. We will also look at the legacy of the Ancient Greeks including art, culture, and the Olympics. In Summer 2, we will do a geographical study of Greece in the modern day.
