## OFSTED Report

Dear Parents and Carers

Please see our OFSTED report below.

We already knew that our school is a 'good' school and that children and staff work really hard every day. I could not ask to work with a more dedicated, caring and truly committed group of staff. It is always lovely for external visitors to also recognise our work too. I shared so much with them about our school, that if they had published it all, the report would be 100 pages long! However, I am particularly proud of some of the things that OFSTED saw whilst they were with us, such as:

**Pupils at Henley Green Primary School try hard every day to live the school values of resilience, respect, kindness, pride, and ambition.** This is very true and our children can talk clearly about our values and what they mean to them.

**The school sets high expectations for pupils' behaviour. Pupils are respectful and kind to one another.** We have worked incredibly hard on our behaviour curriculum to ensure all children are safe and happy. We have created our behaviour rewards and consequences with the children, and have worked with the Department for Education Behaviour Hub to reinforce our work. This has been really successful.

**The curriculum is ambitious for all pupils.**

We have made lots of changes to our curriculum over the last year to ensure that it is reflective of our community whilst being engaging and relevant. We have incorporated more visits and trips to enhance children's experiences. We ensure that children build on their learning from Little Acorns to Year 6.

**Pupils work hard in lessons. They achieve well from their starting points.**

Our children know to try their very best every day. They are taught well and achieve well as a result. Different children make different progress from different starting points! We embrace all children, wherever they are starting.

**Pupils know there are trusted adults that they can talk to in school if they have a worry or concern. Pupils are happy and safe. High-quality pastoral support is provided throughout the day for any pupil who needs it.**

We pride ourselves on the support we give to children – whether it is academic or otherwise and I am really pleased that OFSTED recognised this! We have a dedicated Family Support Team and team of Learning Mentors, who work alongside all adults in school to make sure children can access their learning.
